EXEGESIS #2

When they believe the tale that the serpent tells, that Good and Evil in all things dwells, the fruit of that tree is material life: with struggle, pain, problems and continual strife. >>

EXAMINATIONS - #2

A material outlook sees many minds estranged,
in conflict, dominations, and systems deranged.
And physical forces endangering and causing our demise.
These are the “other gods” the First Commandment cites.
So what comes next? It’s the Fruits of the Spirit, qualities
of Christ, that we see and we be through our spiritual
eyes: love, joy, peace, forbearance, and kindness.
Goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control.
These are the qualities of God our Soul. >>

OUTRO



Golden Text: I Thessalonians (Good News Translation)


May the God who gives us peace make you holy in every way and keep your whole being—spirit, soul, and body—free from every fault at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.

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Responsive Reading: John, Romans


Jesus went up to Jerusalem.

In the temple he found people selling cattle, sheep, and doves and the money changers seated at their tables.

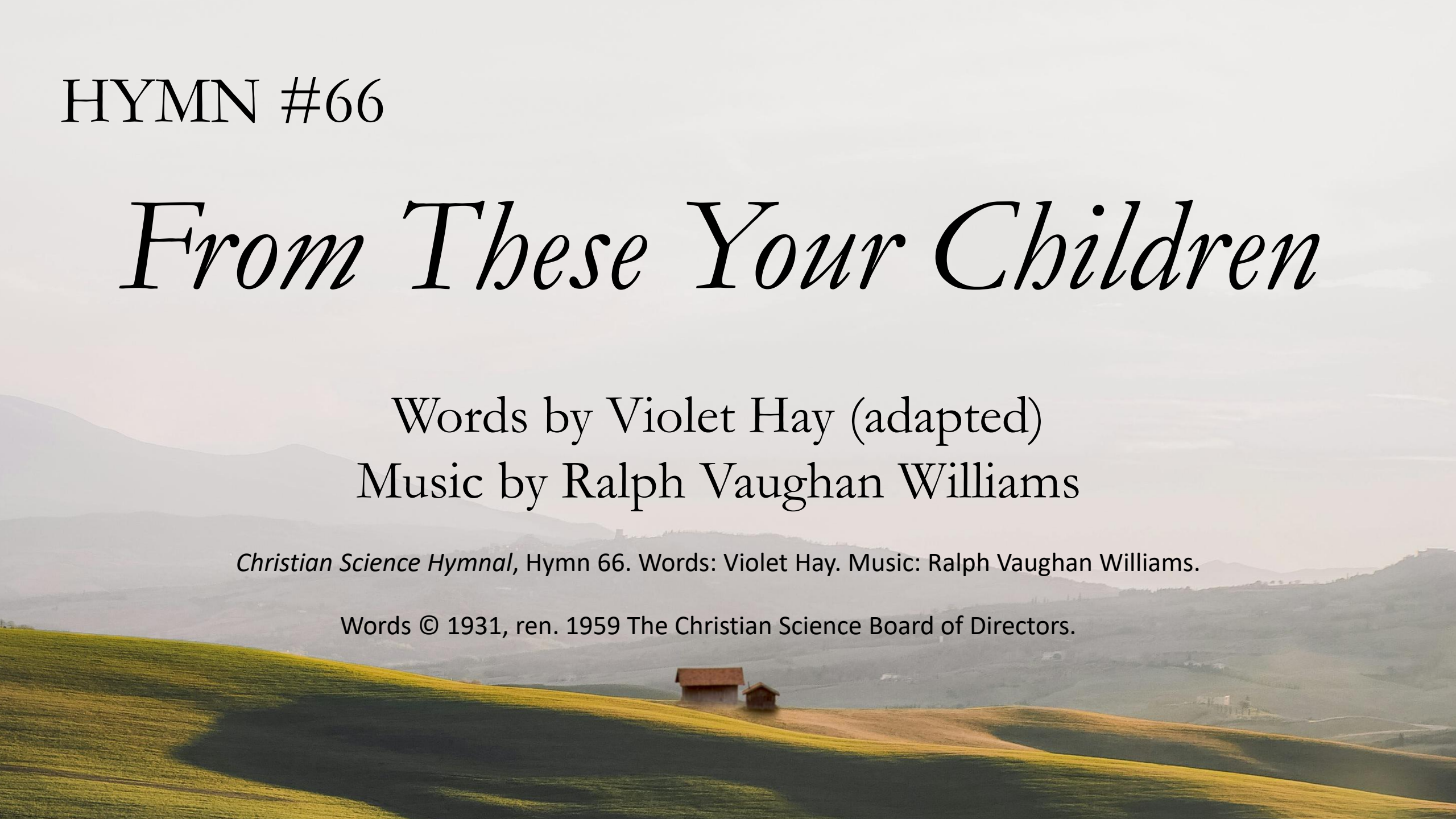
