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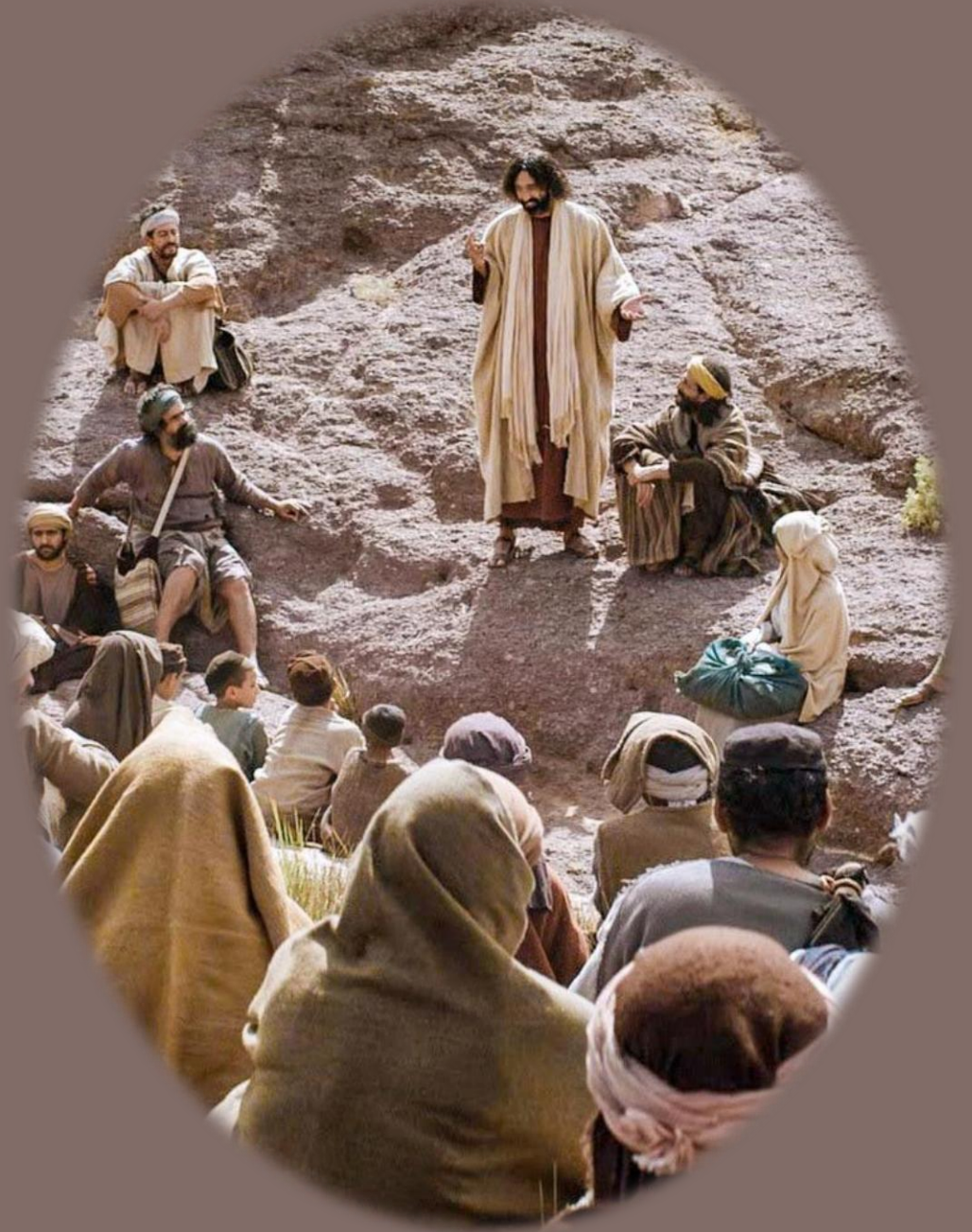


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Come, Messiah, Long Expected

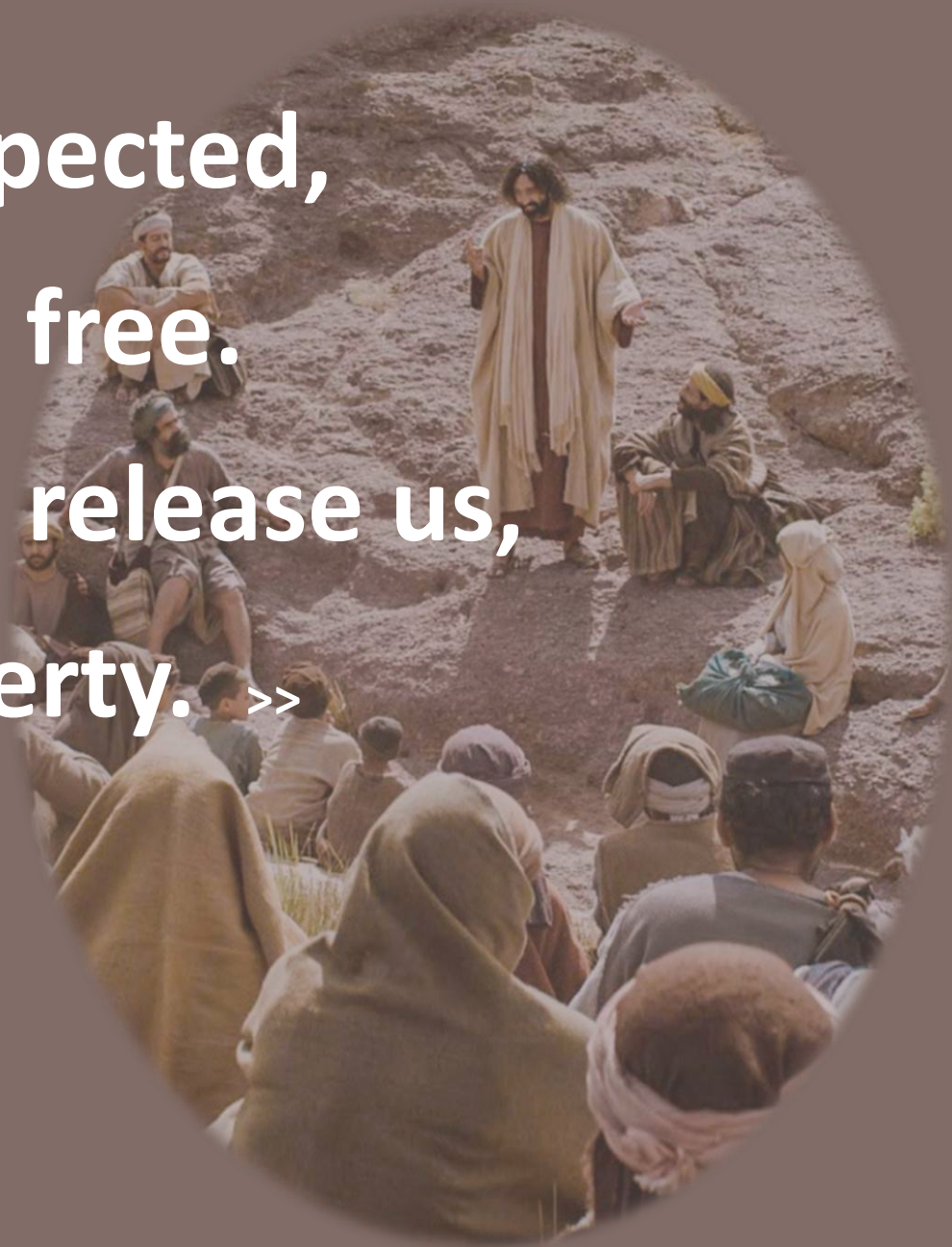

enter every longing heart. >>



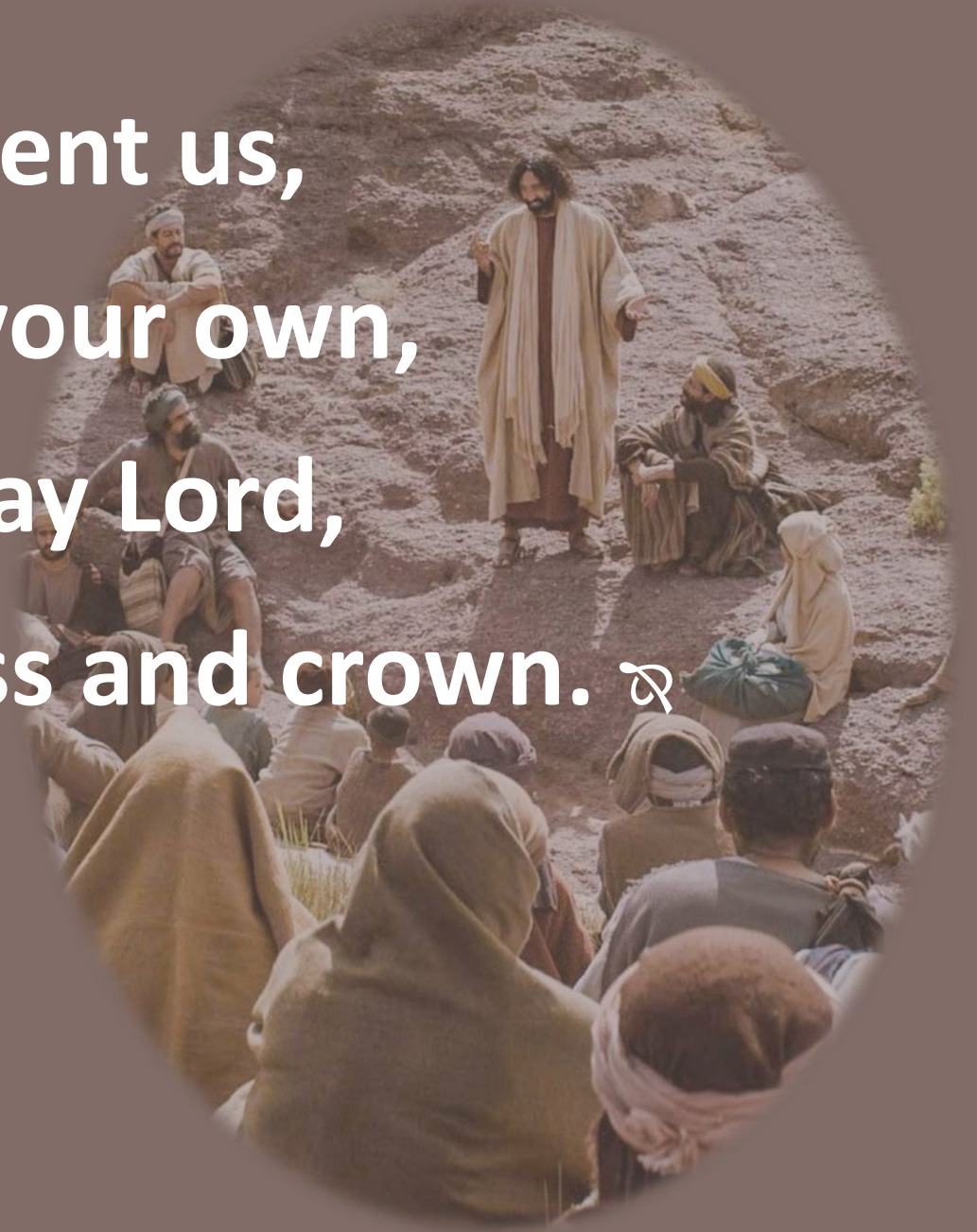
